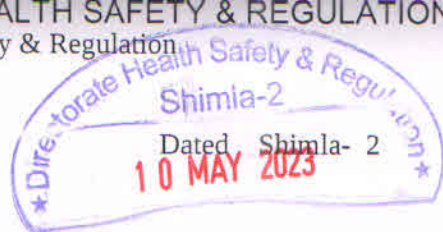

**OFFICE ORDER**

In pursuance to the letter No. PER(AP)C-B(2)-1/2014-V.II dated 30/04/2023 issued by the Department of Personnel and on the recommendations of the Screening Committee of the Directorate of Health Safety & Regulation, H.P., the competent authority is pleased to order regularisation of services of the following Food Safety Officers in the Department of Health Safety & Regulation, in the minimum of Pay Matrix. with immediate effect in public interest: -

The terms and conditions of regularisation are as under:-

Terms and Conditions:-

- 1) The appointment/ regularisation is purely on temporary and liable to be terminated at any time by a month's notice from side viz., the appointee or appointing authority.
- 2) The appointment carries liabilities to serve anywhere in Himachal Pradesh.
- 3) The appointment is further subject to production of following certificates/documents before joining the respective institution.
 - a) Certificate of Medical Fitness issued by the Chief Medical officer/ Sr. Medical Superintendent of the concerned District.
 - b) Certificate of Educational qualification i.e. Matriculation Certificate/ Plus Two educational Certificate & professional qualification possessed by the candidate will be the same as prescribed in R & P Rules framed by the Government for the post of Food Safety officers.
 - c) Character Certificate from the Magistrate of First Class or any Gazetted Officer to whom the candidate is known for the last five years.
 - d) Certificate of Bonafide resident of Himachal Pradesh.
 - e) A certificate of he/she belongs to SC/ST/OBC/WFF/IRDP from the competent authority.
 - f) A declaration that candidate have not/shall not have more than one living husband/wife.
 - g) A declaration to the effect that if any of the information or documents submitted by him/her is found false, he/her service will be terminated without any further notice.
 - h) The appointee shall have to submit, the nomination of Group Insurance Scheme, 1984 at the time of joining of duty.
- 4) That on Regularisation, the officers shall be appointed on the minimum of the pay scale i.e. Rs. 5910-20200 + 3000 (pre-revised) Level-8 in revised pay matrix.

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- 5) These Food Safety officers will be entitled to draw dearness and other allowances at the rate admissible and subject to the conditions laid down in the rules and orders/instructions in force issued by the State Government from time to time.
- 6) The Regularisation shall carry with it the liability to serve in any part of Himachal Pradesh.
- 7) The Regularisation will be on probation, for a period of 2 years and during the period of probation his/her service can be terminated at any time by giving one month's notice or pay in lieu thereof by the appointing authority without assigning any reason.
- 8) The regularisation is subject to the Character and antecedents of the candidates being found satisfactory on verification.
- 9) Taking to an oath of allegiance/faithfulness to the constitution of India or making a solemn affirmation.
- 10) The Officers are required to produce all original certificates in support of their academic/technical qualification, age and reserved class against which they appointed as such.
- 11) The regularisation of the aforesaid Food Safety Officer is subject to the outcome of LPA No. 64/2020, titled as Sudha Batta Vs H.P. Staff Selection Commission & others & LPA No.65/2020 titled as Kamal Kumar Bhardwaj Vs H.P. Staff Selection Commission & others.

If any declaration given or information furnished by the officers is proved to be false or if found to have wilfully suppressed any material information, will be liable for removal from service and such other action as may be deemed necessary.

The above officers are directed to join their duties at their respective places of posting within 15 days and submit their joining reports to this Directorate through proper channel.
